He has released three albums incorporating classic R&B, soul, jazz, and gospel beginning with his 2007 self-titled debut, "Smooth Ingredients" and finally "Summer Breeze". Haywood has also issued a couple of Christmas singles, "Mary, Did You Know?" and "Hark the Herald Angels Sing." and his most recent singles "City Lights" and "Last Dance" were produced and featured "Steve Oliver".

A dynamic concert performer, he has graced a host of Jazz festivals including but not limited to Hartford, Branford, Brass City, Springfield. And Barbados Laughter and Jazz festivals two years consecutively. He has also shared stages alongside Billboard hit makers Chieli Minucci, Elan Trotman, Will Donato, Ray Goodman and Brown, Temptations in review, Kirk Franklin.

Curtis prides himself in his charitable partnerships from "Feed the Children" to Ghana Africa.
